### **Weekday Mass Schedule Change**

This week, June 11-14, is the Priests' Convocation in Columbus. This convocation happens every five years, and all priests in the Archdiocese are required to attend. Because Fr. Paul will be attending the convocation, we will have Liturgy of the Word with Communion Services on Tuesday, June 12, Wednesday, June 13, and Thursday, June 14 at 8:15 am.
