Choosing New Sunday Mass Times

As I had mentioned in my State of the Parish Homily a few weeks ago, we are at that stage where we need to reduce the Sunday Masses from 4 down to 3 each weekend. The Saturday Mass will stay at its present time. Therefore the Worship Commission and I need you to choose the times for the two Sunday Morning Masses. On June 7 and 8, you will be asked which Mass times will be most useful to your family. The first Mass of the morning may begin at 8:00, 8:30, 9:00, or 9:30 am. The second Mass must begin at least two hours after the earlier Mass begins in order to avoid congestion between one mass leaving and another arriving. The second Mass time then could be 10:00, 10:30, 11:00, or 11:30 am, depending on the time of the first Mass. Our hope is that a clear preference for each Mass time will be evident. If so, we will implement the new schedule on July 5 and 6, 2008. If there is no clear preference, we will ask you to choose again from the top picks. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation, and I hope this will not be a difficult transition for you.

School Tuition 2008/09

St. Vivian School is proud to announce that there is NO increase in tuition for the 2008/09 school year! The rates remain \$2,575 for a parishioner student and \$4,000 for a non-parishioner student. This is due to good stewardship on the part of the school and parish, stable school enrollment, and devoted teachers/staff willing to work for less salary than public schools. With the price of everything going up, it is a credit to the leaders of our school and parish that tuition does not have to be raised. So, spread the word - St Vivian School is in healthy shape!
