**Haiti Earthquake Relief Donations**

On January 24, 2010, President Obama signed into law allowing donations for the Haiti Earthquake relief to be deducted as a contribution for 2009. The donations must be made from January 12 through March 1, 2010 and apply only to cash (including check) donations. Our parish tax contribution letters for 2009 that were mailed do not contain any contributions for the Haiti Earthquake. All donations have been posted for 2010. You will then receive an amended parish tax contribution statement. Our donations are forwarded to Catholic Relief Services.

***Free Tax Preparation***

If you are of limited income, don't pay to get your own money back. Your taxes will be prepared for free. If you qualify for the Earned Income Tax Credit, you will receive additional cash back (up to \$4,824). Your return will be e-filed and you can expect your money back in 10-15 days. Call 211 to find the location nearest you to call to see if you qualify and to set up an appointment.

***Please Notify the Parish of Hospitalization***

If you know of a parishioner in the hospital or if you have a planned hospitalization, please let us know. As a patient, please tell the hospital admitting clerk or a pastoral visitor that you would like your church notified.

***Remember Your Parish in Your Will***

Only you can divide your property as you want it divided. A Bequest to your church can be a living memorial to the nobility of your life. A Bequest to your Church is exempt from estate and inheritance taxes, and reduces the amount of the estate to be taxed. Your attorney can assist you.
