**Parish School of Religion (PSR) 2010-2011**

The registration information regarding PSR for the 2010-2011 school year has been mailed to all students from last year. Please note that the registration deadline is September 6, and classes will begin on September 19, from 9:30 until 11:00 am. There are a total of 21 classes scheduled through the middle of May. Fees will remain the same as last year; \$60 for one child, and \$90 for two or more children. Classes are open to all public school or home schooled students between kindergarten and grade eight. We will also have a special class for preschoolers ages three and four, if enough registrations are received. The purpose of this program is to invigorate people of faith to take on the task of bringing new ideas about ways to support Respect Life concepts to Faith communities. These ideas consist of providing information about getting direct support for pregnant women from Pregnancy Centers aligned with the Pregnancy Center Coalition of Greater Cincinnati directly into the hands of the most vulnerable women at risk for abortion and to create an environment of personal compassion among members of the faith community leading some of them to get involved by volunteering at the pregnancy centers. ### *St. Vincent de Paul Society*

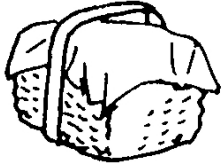
