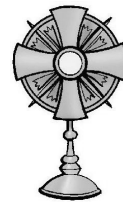
Parish School of Religion (PSR) 2010-2011

Respect Life – Do You Know?

Since 1991 the Ohio Revised Code has deemed nutrition and hydration for patients as "extraordinary care", not basic and normal care. The main Ohio Revised Code provisions dealing with artificial nutrition and hydration were adopted at the time the living will bill was adopted. This is consistent with many states in the US. Living wills may provide a legal vehicle for the removal of nutrition and hydration at the end of life. Persons seeking to prevent "extraordinary" and "heroic" measures at the end of their lives may unintentionally authorize their own starvation and dehydration. If you are interested in learning more about these end of life issues or taking action to address them, the St. Vivian Right to Life group has a place for you.
