WHAT IS IT?

This is when the readings for mass are suitably adapted to make it relevant to the lives and experiences of young children. It gives young children the opportunity to understand the Gospel message and participate in the Eucharist celebration at their own level.

HOW DOES MY CHILD PARTICIPATE?

The children should be seated with their families in the church as usual. When mass begins with the entrance procession, there will be a child carrying a banner in the procession. The children will be brought back into the church after the Prayers of the Faithful, during the collection.
